We will seek, by Divine aid, to live carefully in the world, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, remembering that as we have been buried by baptism and raised again from the symbolic grave, so there is on us a special obligation now to lead a new and holy life. (Romans 6:1-4)

We will work with one another for the continuance of a faithful ministry in the church as we sustain its worship, ordinances, discipline, and doctrines.

We will contribute cheerfully and regularly to the support of the ministry, the expenses of the church, and the mission of the church to make disciples of all nations. (1 Cor. 9:13; 2 Cor. 9:6-9; 1 Tim. 5:9-18)

We will, when we move from this place, as soon as possible, unite with some other church where we can carry out the spirit of this covenant and the principles of God's Word.
